Open House on September 10 was a big success with about 8 squares and Pal Johnson doing what he does best - calling for first timers and making them



Lately, wide & extra-wide elastic is more easily found in fabric & craft stores. In the past these seemed rare and hard to locate. And, while a one piece dress looks fine without any belt at all, the skirt and blouse combinations that are more popular (because of the mix & match and flexible fit advantages) may not look "finished" without a sash or belt of some kind. Most of the time a store bought, solid color regular or stretch belt fills the bill. But if you have the time, desire & minor sewing & craft skills you might try adapting some of the following ideas.

Usually the 3", or even wider elastic is only buyable in basic white or black. The elastic can be encased in a tube of fabric to coordinate or exactly match your skirt, slip, shoes - whatever. Just cut the width of the fabric 2x the width of the elastic, plus 2 seam allowances and cut the length a few inches longer than your "fat days" waist measurement. (Regular poly/cotton is great fabric for this because it isn't too heavy and isn't transparent.) Cut the elastic a few inches shorter than your "thin days" waist measurement.



Fold the fabric lengthwise and stitch a long tube, turn rightside out, slide elastic into tube (you'll all have different ways you prefer to do this) and attach to clasps by treating fabric & elastic ends as one. Usually this is a simple proceedure of putting elastic, from front side of clasp, through a slot & stitching or enclasping back.

If clasps aren't available you can salvage clasps from old worn out belts or buy a stretch belt, take it apart, & cover the new elastic. (This is when sales of unpopularly colored leftovers are good.)

You may want to go one step further if you can't find or don't like the clasps available. Buy "stays" or "boning" (This stuff comes in a roll in a package and can be cut to any length. It is also fabric covered so you can sew it into your fabric & elastic.) and cut a piece for each end of the belt. Either treat your elastic & fabric as one, fold around the "stays" and stitch ends and top & bottom - or - insert "stays" inside tube ends & fold fabric inside itself before stitching. Be sure to stitch on both sides of the "stays" so they don't lay down on the job.

Next, every inch of the clastic width, sew large hooks & eyes or buttons 6 loops (or whatever else you may come up with) on the ends. You can decorate the closure with large decorative

buttons, metal conchas, beaded or stitched appliques, fabric flowers, clusters of beads, seasonal decorations -- Oh, use your own unique, wonderful imaginations !!!




We also enjoyed Harriette Koved's article. The "10 Commandments of Square Dancing" should be posted at each club if necessary and read aloud at a dance as she did.

As this is our first letter to you as the Presidents of the Callers Council of New Jersey, we feel that this would be a good time to introduce CCNJ to one and all.

What is CCNJ? CCNJ is an affiliate of the International Square Dance Callers Association (Callerlab) and is made up of callers and dance leaders

from New Jersey and nearby portions of New York, Pennsylvania, and Connecticut. The amount of experience our members have range from those just starting to those who have been calling more than 40 years. Some call for clubs all across the country, some only call for local clubs, and some only call at non-club functions. Most of the beginner classes taught in the NNJSDA region are taught by CCNJ members, some are active in assisting newer callers to get started, and 3 of the 25 Callerlab Accredited Caller Coaches are members of CCNJ. What brings us together is a desire to foster and promote square dancing in our region and to improve ourselves as callers.

What does CCNJ do? CCNJ meets quarterly to discuss matters of importance to the square dance activity. Our meetings are held in the mornings, the 2nd Saturday of March, June, September and December, at the home of Andy & Ruth Woerner. Most meetings are preceded by a workshop/discussion that is lead by one of our more experienced members. CCNJ sponsors workshops in various aspects of calling that are lead by experts from around the country. CCNJ administers a fund of monies (raised by CCNJ and donations from the NNJSDA) to provide scholarships to members of CCNJ, who desire to go to a formal callers' school. CCNJ also runs a mid-term class

VARIATIONS ON A THEME (or: I Went to the Dance to Show Them My Stuff) by Dick Mazziotti, Caller/Teacher

Comes the season to be jolly, time to sing and watch the holly; clubs are

having student dances; we'll go and help them out, by golly.

Well, okay, remember that this column is addressed to the newer dancers. No one who has been dancing for more than a full year needs to read further because, of course, this will all be second nature. But for newer dancers, what follows is some advice on how to dance with new students at their first dance, and keep in mind that their first 20 dances all still feel like their first dance.


If you have had the opportunity to angel during the first part of the year, you are probably already aware of the need to hush up. This means that while the caller is calling the dancers are dancing. This does not mean that when a dancer makes a mistake they need to be told why they made it, how to fix it and what the caller really meant. Encourage them to form facing lines, by example, not by telling them. More calls are missed and more squares are kept in a perpetual breakdown position by talking, than by Spin Chain Thru.

Concerning all those really "neat" moves you've learned since graduation, as Archie Bunker said to Edith, "Stifle!" The extra twirls, swirls, swings and things are all very nice (maybe) when you are dancing with your peers, but please, please, do not show off to new dancers. It simply confuses them even

further.

Probably the best thing you can ever do for new dancers is try hard to remember your first few dances. A word of encouragement telling each dancer in your square something they did well will go miles further toward keeping them dancing than any other single thing.

- You swing (or follow, or listen, or dance) very well.

- We really enjoyed dancing with you. Will you join us again later? Then be sure to look them up again.

- I saw you Square Thru (or Swing Thru, or Pass Thru) very well. That

was difficult for me when I started.

- Our club is having a student dance at ____. Won't you try to come there to dance with us?

Lastly, partners, please tell your partners to smile, smile, smile, Many of us get rather intent with our dancing and while we may be having a great time inside, we present pinched lips and squinched eyes to other dancers. Doing so to brand new students at their first dance can be devastating. Besides being fun, these dances are to encourage students, not to show them what we can do.

And remember, if we haven't personally helped angel a class this year and haven't attended at least one student dance a month from January on, we can't complain about the quality of dancers. To paraphrase, we have met the enemy and he is us!
