


#### LETTERS TO THE EDITORS. . .

This letter is in response to the letter from Frank & Nan Habersberger, published in the May-August Issue. We would like to take issue with several of the statements contained in the letter and then express an opposing viewpoint.


The Habersbergers mention the standardization started by "Pappy" Shaw in 1935. This is probably in reference to Shaw's "Cowboy Dances" published in 1939 with descriptions and illustrations of square dance figures and dances. It should be noted that the book was primarily a reference manual for traditional, visiting couple-type dances. Of the 68 square dances (for one square only) described, only 8 are not visiting-couple dances. The first real attempt at standardizing Western Square Dancing began around 1963 or 1964 with Bob Osgood's Golden Ribbon Committee. That led to the establishing of the Sets In Order Basic Figures. The letter mentions that this standardization was started so that square dancers could dance the same calls at any location. What the Habersbergers fail to mention is that by the mid 1970s (with no nationally defined levels), it was becoming virtually impossible to do just that: Travel to a dance and know what was going to be called. True, each figure had a definition, but which figures would be used at a dance was anybody's guess. "Club level" was loosely defined as the figures described in the Sets In Order Handbook of Basic and Extended Basic Calls. Unfortunately, there were hundreds of other figures out there that clubs and/or callers had used to expand their repertoire. With each club having their own "favorite" extra calls, it was sometimes an adventure to travel to another club.

This chaos can be illustrated by the way halls were labeled at the National

From NJ Turnpike: Take Exit 8A - Bear right onto Rt 32 West. Take 32 to Rt 130 North. Follow from 130 below.

From Rt 130: Take Rt 522 (7.4 miles south of Rt 1 or 1.8 miles north of Rt 32) toward Dayton. Stay on 522 for 4.1 miles. There will be one left turn at a light to stay on 522. Ignore signs for Ridge Rd. Turn left onto Stouts Lane. The school will be about 1 mile on the right.

Erom Rt. 1: 8.4 miles south of Rt 130 or 9.8 miles north of Rt 95, go east on Stouts. After you exit off Rt I you will have to turn right onto Stouts Lane. The school will be about 1 mile on the right.

#### LETTERS TO THE EDITORS...

In May 1999, we completed five Patron Cards in a little more than one year. These are our 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th cards with 22, 17, 18, 17, and 18 proper signatures respectively. Originally we thought we might complete two cards until the 65% rule came into effect when we decided to give our personal support to as many clubs as possible as Patrons. We hope this gesture might lead other dancers to become active Patrons. In addition, we feel saddened by the demise of 1/4 of the Association clubs since we graduated in 1995 and we hope this will not continue.

Another square dance milestone occurred for us on May 8th. We completed our 5th Century Book for our 500th (all different) callers. To eliminated duplicate callers, we recorded each callers' name and date in chronological sequence, then transferred these names to an alphabetical list so if a duplicate appeared, it could be compensated for by an additional name. On the latter list we recorded sequence number, caller name, caller hometown, date of the dance, name of the dance, and its location. At this point, we have danced in 26 states and Canada, with 119 different clubs on their regular nights plus numerous conventions and believe we have covered more than 65,000 miles. We may have pushed ourselves a bit, but at 70++ it's "do it while you can."

Presently only 100, 200, and 300 Century pins are available. We're working with the editors of *Northeast Square Dancer* magazine to get the Century Club people to produce a 400 and 500 pin. We think we see some progress on this subject.

physically challenged dancers, run by our own Arnold Walker.



Our pot-luck supper was a big success with a pleasing variety of scrumptious dishes.



Evening approaches. Sometime during the day, one or the other of us will be asking, "Shall we go to the dance tonight?" All too often the answer is, "Nahh."

What provokes such an answer, when we all know that all square dancers would rather square dance than do anything else? Sometimes it's just being at the wrong end of a long day and we're too tired. Sometimes it's a caller we've just danced to and would rather not again. Sometimes it's a club where we do not feel welcome. Sometimes it's snobbishness that we're A-2 dancers and the dance is Mainstream. Or we're "good" dancers, and the dancers at this dance are not so "good."

Let's take a look at some of the reasoning above and see if we can talk each

other into going to more, not fewer, dances this summer and fall.

Too tired/too long a day: Certainly health consideration should take precedence, and dancing, or any other physical activity performed when exhausted is not good. But it should be remembered that laughter, social contact, and some exercise, are all strongly recommended for getting a good night's sleep. In other words, when you're feeling tired and out of sorts, an evening of light exercise, good friends, and a good time can actually make you feel better and

sleep better than being a slug sitting at home.

Consider the poor caller. While we may enjoy dancing to some more than others, I'll tell you a little secret about "good" dances versus "not so good" dances. Callers can have an effect on the dance, but it is you, the dancers, who set the tone for each dance. At some clubs, the dancers ignore the caller and caller's partner, gather in the back of the hall, talk with each other in cliques, ignore strangers and square up reluctantly. At others, the caller is greeted, someone makes sure his or her partner is offered a chance to dance (not required—offered), dancers coming in are met at the door and made welcome, and dancers not only square up right away, but they banter with the caller, offer refreshments, etc. Which dance do you think will be upbeat? I can tell you, with the best of intentions, any caller faced with a dour, sour crowd of dancers will not present as "good" a dance as when made to feel welcome and part of the party.

"Higher level" dancers who do not want to dance at "lower levels" are like people who eat only dessert. They know it's not healthy to avoid the basic food groups, but they gorge on sugar and cream. The activity, and their dancing abilities, suffer. As we have seen over and over again, some of the difficult calls for all dancers, including those who dance Plus, Advanced, and Challenge, continue to be the Mainstream calls. Dancers who regularly avoid Mainstream dances are also withholding their considerable dance talents to make the

Mainstream experience enjoyable for everyone.

"Good dancer/bad dancer." Sometimes clubs acquire a reputation for being a "good" dancing club or a "bad" dancing club. Incidentally, most clubs go through this, even the ones which announce themselves as "high level." Well, if you consider yourself a "good" dancer, and you go anyway, you raise the level of the floor; you contribute to the dance experience for other dancers; you make the club just a little better each time you go. In other words, you are really being a

Conventions. In 1967, there were Programmed Squares and Programmed Relaxed Squares. In 1970, there were Programmed Squares, Challenge, and Hot Hash. In 1975, there were Programmed Squares, Advanced, Hot Hash, and Challenge. (Notice that Hot Hash has gone from being harder than Challenge to being easier.) In 1976, there were plateaus A, B, C, and D. Throughout all of this confusion, Callerlab was formed to try and standardize the activity and create a structure for its continued growth and expansion. The "lists" did not create the levels, they simply defined the ones that were already there and provided for future changes. Being a folk activity, square dancing will continually evolve and change. The system of lists was designed to try and accommodate this evolution.

The Habersbergers' letter mentioned a "new generation of callers" that, in 1990, advocated a new program called "Square Dance." To call the American Callers Association a new generation of callers is incorrect. The ACA was formed by two callers, each with over 30 years' calling experience, who quit Callerlab because they were not getting their way. The new "Square Dance" program that they were proposing would have taken at least 30 weeks to teach. A careful examination of their program reveals that they eliminated very few of the figures that currently exist on the Mainstream and Plus lists. They simply grouped them

into "families" so it looked like a shorter list.

Between us, we have attended 63 National Conventions, and been on enough panels that we can't remember all of them. We have also served on and moderated panels at Callerlab, Roundalab, and Legacy. The questions about shortening the lists, combining the lists, and reducing the teaching period have been discussed at all of these. Every time serious research has been done, proposals presented, and votes taken, the results have been the same. There is nothing wrong with our activity! We have a product that is enjoyable and 100% politically correct. There is no downside to our product. The problem is not with what we dance. Everyone at a dance, regardless of the level, is there enjoying themselves. The biggest problems facing square dancing are recruitment and retention. They are problems because of bad marketing and bad attitudes. Each one of these could be discussed at considerable length, but we will address each of them briefly here.

Marketing: As long as we have this "hee-haw" image of a bunch of hicks in outlandish costumes having a s--- kicking good time, we will never grow. Callerlab is in the process of raising tens of thousands of dollars for the expressed sole purpose of hiring a top-notch professional market research firm to figure out

how to get our message to the public.

We, in the meantime, need to realize that recruitment isn't a six-week hard sell just before classes begin. It is a year-round soft sell, taking every opportunity to explain our aerobic, mentally challenging, social activity. Our demos and beginner dances must have music that is tailored to that specific audience, both dancers and spectators. We need to have people asking us when they might try this, not us begging them to "take square dance lessons." The length of lessons has nothing to do with whether people will join. Whether it takes 10 weeks or 30 weeks, if people are enjoying themselves, with friends, in a party/dance atmosphere, they will continue.

The decline in numbers is not due to deterioration of our activity. It is due to a failure to keep up with the changing times. Remember, during our rise in numbers, we didn't have to compete with the Internet, fitness clubs on every


The informal dance held on the last Wednesday of June was well attended

corner, and Blockbuster Video. Many of the baby boomers that we lost dropped out because they had kids. What provisions have been made for families at square dances to maybe get some of them back? How many adults will take an adult education class a couple times a week? Has anyone considered teaching square dancing two nights a week and thus getting an entire set of lessons completed in 12 weeks? This is where our efforts should be directed. Our folk activity has evolved to its present state because this is what the dancers have chosen to do. Now we need to concentrate on convincing the rest of the world that our product is worth buying into.

Attitudes: The Habersbergers talk about twice as many Plus clubs as Mainstream clubs in their area. They then comment that if we had this new program, then 72% of their clubs could accept new graduates. In other words, the Plus clubs can't accept new graduates. Why? Is dancing Mainstream too demanding for Plus dancers? Do the Plus clubs even offer lessons? Do they offer lessons and then not teach all the way to Plus, or not provide the new dancers a place to dance? We have a Mainstream club which just celebrated its 45th anniversary. The club presidents are C-4 dancers. The other officers are Advanced dancers. The entire membership includes only one "Mainstream" couple; the rest dance Plus or "higher." The club absolutely refuses to become a Plus club because they believe there must be places for Mainstream dancers, and they still enjoy the sociability of the Mainstream club.

Many years ago, there was a Plus 1 and a Plus 2 program (Callerlab encourages the use of the word "program" instead of level). In an effort to encourage more Mainstream clubs, the Plus 1 program was combined with the Plus 2 program to make it more a jump from Mainstream to the next program. The American mentality always equates more with better. Who is to say that with the proposed new programs, the new Advanced program would not gradually become the equivalent of today's Plus program?

In closing, let's put this talk about changing the programs behind us. It has been debated for over five years. The ACA tried to build an organization around it, and their numbers have dwindled dramatically. Callerlab spent two years developing a proposal based on the concept of changing the entry-level program, and it was defeated by a vote of the general membership. Time after time it has been decided that there is nothing wrong with our product. Let's stop trying to change the product, and start trying to sell the product.




