

We can all be very proud of this kind of support which we are certain is greatly appreciated by the National.

To "play" upon our continuing theme, we extend a gentle reminder that we must be about working more closely in support of our fledgling clubs, and making "Friendly Clusters" a reality. In some dire cases, rather than permit a club(s) to fold, we might encourage the formation of merger(s). It is strongly suggested that each of our clubs begin to actively "reach out" to their local high schools, and form youth alliances. We also suggest that, where feasible, each club solicit and include a Youth Coordinator as a full-fledged officer on its Executive Board. Conceivably, this officer would serve as the liaison between the high school youth group and the club. Let's look forward to the goal of having at least three or four of our clubs forming high school square dance youth clubs during the 2000-2001 season. Any efforts that are made toward achieving this goal will be greatly appreciated and applauded.

As we begin a new square dance season, we trust that your recruitment efforts shall have been fruitful, and that the "new recruits" will have the commitment and tenacity to successfully complete the Basic/Mainstream programs, thereby swelling our ranks in the year 2001. Let us, also, begin planning to attend the 50th National Convention in Anaheim, California. More information shall be forthcoming.


Sorely missed by our members and friends.

In my last article, I asked for suggestions as to how to recruit new entry-level dancers and how to encourage greater attendance at Mainstream dances. As of this writing, I have not received a single suggestion. Hopefully, this does not mean we are content with the small classes we have had in the past several

years and in the poor attendance at all dance levels (specifically Mainstream, which is the entry level). If we continue as we are and do nothing, it would not surprise me to

eventually see this wonderful activity cease to exist.

Many clubs consistently use the traditional way of trying to recruit and hold new dancers. This continually results in small classes, or in some cases, no class at all. I believe we need to try some new strategies and programs to attract more new dancers. Callerlab has hired a marketing company to come up with methods to promote our activity. They have found that most people have a favorable impression of square dancing. We next need to find a way to channel this favorable impression. It seems that what we have been doing is attractive to people, but does not encourage too many people to join us.

One thought is a combined group of NNJSDA clubs in our area running the classes with several CCNJ callers each being asked to teach one or two of the class dates. If the clubs coordinated their classes, the workload would be distributed among several

callers for the benefit of a larger number of students.

In order to discuss the concerns facing our square dance activity, I propose a meeting of the Presidents of all area clubs, NNJSDA, and CCNJ. This would allow for insight from several different perspectives and, perhaps, we might come to understand the problems that face each aspect of the activity.

Presidents, please look for an invitation to a meeting sometime in the Fall, and dancers, I'm still hoping for suggestions and comments. Our e-mail addresses are Bob:




