



Turn Left on Dogwood Drive; turn left after 5 houses into school driveway. Valley Middle School is .5 miles. Turn Right on Oak St. Take 1st left into Borough Hall parking lot and then immediate right down hill to side of Valley School. From Wayne, take Berdan Ave. to end; turn left on Longhill Rd. to traffic light; turn right on Rt.202; take 2nd right onto Dogwood Drive.

new slate of officers effective September 1. The bad news is that we must increase admissions by \$1.50 as of our first dance on September 14 in order to meet the increased rent at the new location.




NEW for the Mini-Festival: A Singles Registry

DIRECTIONS TO FLORENCE M. BURD (FMB) SCHOOL

FROM THE EAST: Take Route 80 West to Exit 34B (Route 15 North). Go about 10.6 miles to the second Sparta exit. Route 517 South (the first is the business district exit). Turn left onto 517 South. Go straight at second light (Shell Station on right). After about 1 mile Route 517 turns left; go straight (Route 616 West) for approximately 2 miles to the next light. Go straight through the light for about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE WEST: Take Route 80 East to Exit 19. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 517 North. Route 517 bears right at the blinker light 2.5 miles from route 80. Stay on Route 517 North for another 4 miles until you get to the junction of Route 206 in Andover. Turn left onto Route 206 North. Proceed about one mile to the Exxon station on the right. Turn right onto Limecrest Road (Route 669) and follow for 3.7 miles to the next light. Turn left onto Newton-Sparta Road and go about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Either come north on Route 287, get on Route 80 West and follow "**FROM THE EAST**" directions or come north on Route 206, get on Route 80 West for a very short distance, take exit 25 (Route 206 North). From here, go 6.5 miles to the Exxon Station in Andover on the right, turn right onto Limecrest Road
