Averaging over 240 engagements per year, she has called throughout the United States as well as Canada, England, Sweden, and Germany.

As an accredited Callerlab Caller-Coach, she has taught Caller schools and clinics throughout the U. S and in Canada and England.

Betsy was the first American woman elected to the Callerlab Board of Governors, and the first American woman to become an Accredited Caller-Coach.


