

# NNJSDA 2024-2025 VISITATION PROGRAM

The NNJSDA Visitation Program promotes interaction among clubs and provides a financial incentive for visiting other member clubs. Points are awarded for each visit based on the number of club members visiting.

**Visitation Goal: 60 or more points**

## **Visitation Rewards:**

- \* Fun dancing with other clubs
- \* Reduction in NNJSDA dues

## **Requirements/Guidelines**

1. Visits must take place between June 1, 2024, and May 31, 2025.
2. Visits must include at least 5 official members of the visiting club who pay the visited club's dance admission fee or use a free dance coupon and are not also members of the visited club.
3. Visits must be to a dance on the club's regularly scheduled date or NNJSDA cleared date (not a workshop or beginner dance). If a club's regularly scheduled dance is a student-level dance, current students of a visiting club who are not also registered as students at the visited club and pay the admission fee may be counted.
4. As a courtesy, notify the president of the visited club in advance that you are visiting and provide the approximate number of visitors.
5. The attached Visitation Form must be signed and dated by an officer of the visited club who will also write in the number of eligible visitors (*see rules 2, 6, and 7*).
6. If two clubs visit another club on the same day, dancers who are members of both visiting clubs will count as visitors for only one of the visiting clubs (their choice).
7. Clubs may visit any other member club as often as desired but no more than 15 points can be accumulated for visiting a specific club per Visitation Form. If a club wishes to complete the Visitation Program twice in a given year, the same club can be counted again.
8. Clubs must accumulate at least 60 points based on the attached Visitation Form.
9. Clubs that complete the Visitation Program will receive a dues reduction of 50 cents per member in the following year each time the program is completed (up to twice a year).

## **How to Use the Visitation Form**

1. Enter the visiting club's name at the top of the Visitation Form.
2. Fill out one line of the Visitation Form and have an officer of the visited club sign, date, and add the number of visitors. Fill in the names of the visitors on the supplemental sheets.
3. When the total number of points reaches at least 60, send the Visitation Form to the NNJSDA Secretary (*see Grand Square* or NNJSDA website).

**Make a copy of the completed Visitation Form before mailing it to the NNJSDA Secretary or retain the original if emailing scanned Visitation Form.**
