

INCENTIVE PROGRAMS OFFERED THROUGH THE NNJSDA

For Clubs

[Note: Both programs may be completed twice in a single dance year.

However, the maximum dues reduction for any year is 100%.]

RAID – The Raid program promotes interaction among clubs and provides a financial incentive for visiting other clubs. Points are awarded for each raid based on the distance between the clubs. Raids must take place between June 1 and May 31; must include at least one square of official club members; and must be to a regular dance (not a special or dinner-dance). Clubs may not limit the number of clubs raiding a particular dance, although for time management they may limit the number of “marches” or have all raiding clubs march in together. Clubs must accumulate a specified number of points, have the raid chart signed by each raided club, and provide the original form to the NNJSDA Recording Secretary. Clubs that complete the program receive a dues reduction the following year.

ONE SQUARE IS FAIR – The One Square Is Fair program rewards member clubs for supporting NNJSDA events. Clubs that have at least one square of official club members in attendance at a specified number of scheduled NNJSDA dances (including The Gathering, Mini-Festival, and Midterm Class-Level Dance) from June 1 through May 31 receive a dues reduction the following year. Note: Students who are officially registered in a club’s Mainstream class count toward OSIF at the Midterm Dance. The NNJSDA Treasurer keeps a record of clubs that earn OSIF credit at each NNJSDA event.

For Individual Dancers

FREELoader – Any member of an NNJSDA club who attends three of the Association’s summer dances plus the Mini-Festival in the same year and has the Freeloader form signed by the NNJSDA Treasurer at each event will earn a dangle and free admission to a future NNJSDA dance. This award can be earned every year.

PATRON – Any member of an NNJSDA club who attends regular dances (not specials or dinner-dances) at 65% of the Association clubs, has the Patron form signed by each club visited, and provides the original form to the NNJSDA Recording Secretary will earn a dangle and a coupon valued at the current admission fee for an NNJSDA dance. There is no time limit for earning this award, and no limit on the number of times it can be earned. Check the form posted on the NNJSDA website for the current number of signatures required.

Non-NNJSDA Programs

Callers’ Council of New Jersey Caller Dangle – Get a signature card from the CCNJ and obtain the signatures of 12 different CCNJ callers at any regular dance, workshop, class, or demo. No more than two callers may sign on any day. Upon completion, send the card to CCNJ and receive a dangle. There is no time limit for earning this award. (This program is encouraged, but not sponsored, by the NNJSDA.)

Callers Black Book – Purchase a Callers Black Book from the NNJSDA Treasurer or Ken Ritucci (\$10) and earn medallions upon obtaining 75 (Bronze), 125 (Silver), 200 (Gold), and 250 (Platinum) signatures, plus badges engraved with your name for Gold and Platinum. (This program is encouraged, but not sponsored, by the NNJSDA.)
