
We are holding our annual Graduate's Ball in May with Jules Pozsar calling and cordially extend an invitation to all teachers and their classes to join us for that evening, and others too!

Here is the first of a series, by Steve & Dorothy Musial - General Chairman of the 26th National, of "What a National Convention is all about"

How did the National Square Dance Convention get to be so great and how does it continue to get better each year? We will try to tell you why we think so in a series of forthcoming articles.

Over the years these past Chairmen, the National Executive Committee, have written and refined a statement of Policies for Conducting a National S/D Convention. In addition to these helpful references, the National Committee visits the National Convention host city (On the Boardwalk in '77) fifteen months prior to the convention date to confer with and advise the General Chairmen and his Committee.







That's right...a shower curtain into a square dance cape!


I used a Mc Call pattern #2927, however other patterns that would have been suitable were also available. Look for a style that gives width at the hemline to cover up our square dance dresses and something with a minimum of seams.

This pattern featured an attached hood, easier to throw over your hairdo and not as easy to misplace. Shower curtains are 6 feet square, so select your pattern and make any adjustments, if necessary. Spread newspapers out on the floor to make a 6' square area. Place your pattern out on it to best advantage. Remember, plastic has no 'fabric grain'. This will assure you in your purchase if a second curtain is required.

Select a shower curtain that is plain or has an all-over design rather than a definite one-way design. Also, pick plastic rather than a sheer or taffeta with lining, you want something that will protect you from the rain. A word of caution on flocked curtains- they may 'wear' just in the area where you sit as these were not designed to be worn. But there are many suitable ones including checks, dots & geometrics.

Now for construction- I trimmed away the hemline as the entire cape is edged in fold-over braid. Remember not to backtack as this causes extra holes and may tear; instead tie your ends of threads. First join your 2 hood pieces on center back seam. Next, sew shoulder seams, these could be enclosed in tape to reinforce. Next sew center back seam. Now enclose entire edge of hood in braid; trim away cape portion neckline seam allowance (otherwise neck may be too tight fitting), enclose all edges of cape in braid. Join lower edge of hood to neck edge of cape. Hem a length of braid for a tie, sew half to each side at neck edge. Sew a hook and eye on inside at neck edge to ease the strain. You may choose to close it with velcro, frogs, or additional hooks & eyes, just remember only to sew through the tape not on the bare plastic.

Lightweight plastic picnic tablecloths may also be used, however it will probably take 2 and I strongly urge laying the pattern out beforehand. Also do not use pins to pin your pattern to the plastic use small canned goods as paper-weights. Any difficulty???? Come to a Y SQUARES dance and I'll help you in person.



## CONSIDERATE SQUARES - No. 2 WAIST SWING



Like any two-person figure, the center of the waist swing is that point between the two dancers involved. Each turns equally around this center turning spot. Keep your left elbow slightly raised to describe the circular orbit your swing will be making.



Keeping right feet together, use your left foot as a pusher in short smooth stroking steps.


