

From the computer of... Bob & Mary King, NNJSDA Presidents





Currently, 32 states have adopted legislation designating the square dance as their state folk dance. Legacy International, working with Representative Jim Saxton (NJ), had bill H.J.Res. #15 introduced in the House on February 8, 2001. This bill would designate the square dance as the National Folk Dance of the United States in perpetuity. To date, there are six co-sponsors. As Committee Chairman, I have been actively involved in lobbying many congressmen to solicit more co-sponsors and support for the bill.

Representative Jim Saxton has written me saying, "...it is important for your members to continue to contact their congressmen, urging them to support the resolution. The more your members write letters and make phone calls to their congressmen, the more success we will have in passing H.J.Res. #15." The 22nd Governor's Conference on Recreation for Individuals with Disabilities was held at the Princeton Marriott, Forrestal Village, on May 14, 2001. The theme was "Moving the Human Spirit." Pal Johnson of Lakeland Squares conducted a square dance demonstration. The purpose was to demonstrate that disabled individuals can be integrated into a regular square. Pal had not one, but three disabled people in one square – a blind dancer, a dancer in a wheelchair, and a dancer with Down's Syndrome. For good measure, we also had a dancer who is hard of hearing. Dancing from Lakeland Squares were Barbara Johnson and Janet and Angelo Montagnino.

LETTER FROM THE EDITORS...

Two more clubs, Dingman Dancers and Warren Wheelers, have found it necessary to close due to lack of participation. This continues a trend that must be reversed if square dancing is to survive.

One idea that was tried by Alamo Dancers in Texas is to have beginning classes as part of square dance weekends. The club would then welcome the new dancers by offering tips they can enjoy at regular dances as well as offering additional lessons.

Other ideas include:

1. Charging for an introductory open house or barn dance, but giving out free passes that night for lessons.
2. Al-e-Mo Squares assigns angels to designated students. Responsibilities of the angels include encouraging the students, monitoring their progress, following up if they miss lessons, and reporting progress/issues to the club coordinator.
3. A data base of names gathered at demos and barn dances is shared by all the Gay Clubs in California. Letters listing all available lessons go out to the list.

We are anxious to have *any* ideas that will help revitalize square dancing. Let us know what you are doing to bring in and retain new members. We will continue to publish your ideas so that other clubs can try them.


As we begin this new dance season, let us all strive to keep in mind what this activity is truly all about - making new friends and having fun. Happy Dancing!!
